PACKAGES

The process for booking campsites for the Animoca Brands Australian Motorcycle Grand Prix 2022 has changed.

The team have been working hard to ensure the process for booking camping is streamlined, with the new processes introduced for 2022 designed to reduce overcrowding, keep the cost of group bookings down and ensure the safety and security of all our campers.

To avoid disappointment and ensure you are fully prepared for this year's event, fans intending on camping at Phillip Island should be aware that:

- All campsites must be pre-booked prior to arrival – there will be NO ability to purchase campsites once you've arrived at Phillip Island.
- In 2022, campsites are sold per site with an additional per person fee for each camper.
- Each camper will be sent a wristband prior to the event - please note, NO ACCESS to campgrounds will be granted without a wristband.
- All campsites are either pre-selected or allocated – there is NO NEED for people to line up for days in advance to secure a site in 2022.

Please ensure you take note of site sizes as you will be unable to utilise any space outside of your purchased site.

All requested amendments to your booking are subject to availability.

Please also note that your campground booking does not grant you access to the circuit, and a valid ticket to the event is also required to enter the circuit.

Highside North

This campground caters to motorcycles, cars, caravans, campervans, buses, and motorhomes, with each campsite being **8m x 8m** in size.

If you want a bit more space, get in quickly to secure two campsites next to one another. Alternatively, sites in the Highside South Campground are larger.

Highside South

The Highside South Campground is designed for larger vehicles such as caravans and RVs with each site **13.8m x 7m**.

Multiple sites can be purchased if you require additional space but make sure you get in quick to secure two sites next to each other.

Trackside and Trackside Premium

The Trackside Campground boasts views of the Southern Loop and is reserved for patrons with motorcycles and tents only. Plots are sized at **6m x 6m**.

Premium views are also available for select sites, but you'll need to be fast because these will sell out quickly.

FAQS

WHAT SIZE ARE THE CAMPSITE PLOTS?

Campground plots vary in size depending on the type of plot purchased.

Trackside: 6m x 6m

Highside North: 8 m x 8m

Highside South: 13.8m x 7m angled plot

Pre-Pitched (tent size)

Single: 3m x 3m

Twin: 3m x 3m

Triple: 3m x 3.6m

Quad: 6m x 3.6m

MY CARAVAN IS BIGGER THAN THE SINGLE PLOT, CAN I BUY TWO SIDE BY SIDE?

Yes, you can purchase plots side by side when securing your plot online.

HOW MANY VEHICLES CAN I PARK IN MY PLOT?

One vehicle is permitted entry per campground plot that has been purchased.

WE'LL HAVE MORE THAN 1 CAR, WHERE CAN I PARK IT?

Overflow parking is available and can be purchased when booking your campground tickets online.

WHEN ARE THE CAMPGROUNDS OPEN?

Campgrounds will open at 12pm Thursday 13th October for patrons to begin arriving and setting up their campsite for the event.

CAN I ARRIVE AND QUEUE ONSITE PRIOR TO THURSDAY?

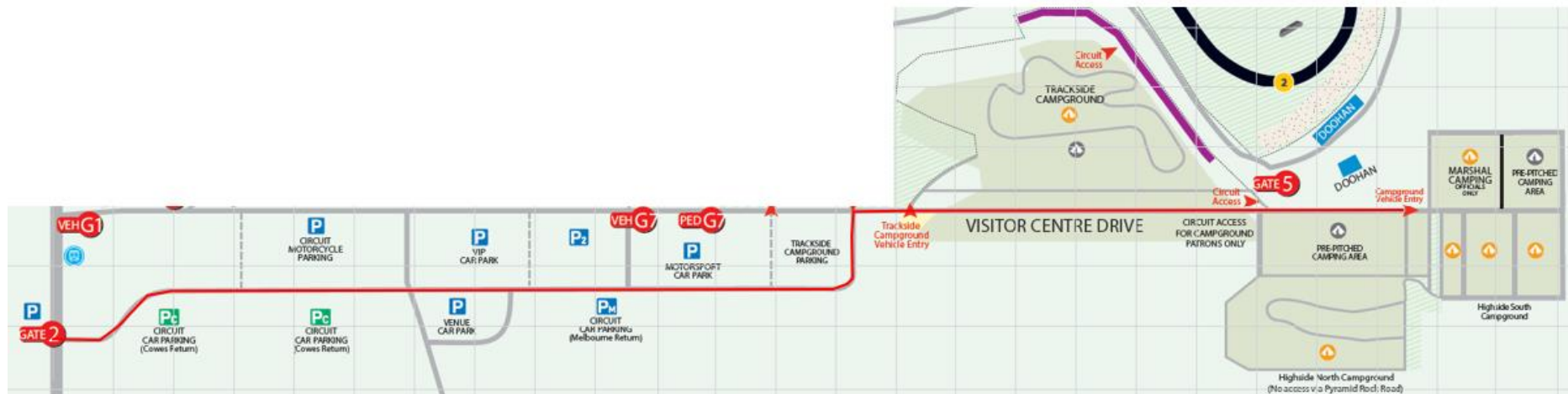
No queuing or camping is allowed on site prior to Thursday. With our new per site allocation system the site you have purchased is guaranteed. You may arrive anytime from 6am on Thursday morning in preparation for the Campgrounds to be opened at 12pm.

WHERE DO I ENTER THE CAMPGROUNDS?

Access to the campgrounds is available via Gate 2 along the Gate 2 Road. Please follow all directional signage that will be displayed to assist with your arrival.

PATRONS MUST HAVE A WRISTBAND TO ACCESS CAMPGROUNDS.

THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS



WHAT IS THE COST?

To camp at the MotoGP, firstly you must reserve a plot, prices starting at \$200. Once reserved, select how many patrons will be staying on this plot with you. Each patron is priced at \$50.

ARE THESE PRICES PER NIGHT?

No, prices are for the duration of the event.

DOES THE COST OF CAMPING INCLUDE MY ENTRY INTO THE EVENT?

No, tickets to enter the event must also be purchased separately.

CAN I PURCHASE TICKETS SEPARATELY TO CAMPING TICKETS?

Yes, however please note a ticket to attend the event does not grant access to campgrounds.

CAN I PURCHASE A CAMPSITE AT THE EVENT ONCE I HAVE ARRIVED?

No, all camping must be purchased before arrival to Phillip Island. We cannot guarantee availability for your request. Please ensure you pre-book your camping access online via www.motogp.com.au

HOW MANY PARKING PASSES DO I GET FOR EACH SITE?

1 vehicle is permitted entry per campground plot that has been purchased.

CAN I BUY ADDITIONAL PARKING SPOTS?

Yes, you can purchase additional carpark spots for any extra vehicles you have when booking your campgrounds tickets online. However, these vehicles must be parked in the overflow carpark section.

CAN WE HAVE A CAMPFIRE?

Yes, you are permitted to have a fire in all campgrounds, firewood will be readily Available for purchase on site.

IS BYO ALCOHOL PERMITTED?

No, BYO Alcohol is not permitted. Alcohol must be purchased at the venue.

IS GLASS PERMITTED?

No, glass is not permitted to be brought into the event (except glass jars containing 300g or under of vegemite, jams or food preservatives).

CAN I BYO FOOD?

Yes, you can BYO food. Food outlets will also be positioned in both Trackside and Highside campgrounds for patrons to purchase hot food and cold drinks.

The Champions Café at the Visitor Centre will also be opened for campers to purchase food and beverages. Access to the Visitor Centre will be via the main gate from the circuit (during event hours). When the circuit is closed, access will be available from the Trackside campground.

CAN I BRING MY BBQ OR ANY OTHER COOKING APPARATUS?

In respect of campfires lit and barbeques used in the Camping Grounds, Patrons acknowledge and agree to the following:

- (a) campfires must only be lit in either a container that properly contains the fire or in a trench that is no greater than thirty cm deep. The size of the fire will not exceed 1 metre in diameter;
- (b) all campfires must be kept at a reasonable and manageable size, and the ground and airspace within three metres of the fire must be clear;
- (c) an adult (over the age of eighteen years) must be in attendance at all times whilst the barbeque or campfire is alight;
- (d) fires are not to be lit inside Tents or other structures; and
- (e) naked flames such as candles are not permitted within Tents or other structures.

CAN I GET A POWERED SITE?

Yes, you can book a powered site for the event. This must be booked prior to arrival at the Campgrounds via the website www.motogp.com.au/tickets/campgrounds

WHAT FACILITIES ARE PROVIDED AT THE CAMPGROUNDS?

The facilities at the Campground include toilets, showers, food and beverage stalls, shelter, and entertainment marquees.

WHAT ACCESSIBLE AMENITIES ARE AVAILABLE?

Accessible Amenities at the Campgrounds include showers, toilets and accessible shuttles.

WHAT HAPPENS IN BAD WEATHER?

Should the event be impacted by severe weather, please bring appropriate wet weather gear/attire.

ARE PETS ALLOWED?

No, pets are not allowed.

CAN I BRING MY UNREGISTERED BIKE/VEHICLE INTO THE EVENT?

No, all vehicles at the event must have relevant and valid registration to brought into the event.

CAN I BRING FURNITURE?

Excessive furniture that blocks or impedes the view of other patrons is not permitted.

CAN I RESERVE AREAS AROUND THE TRACK BY SECTIONING/CORDONING OFF AREAS TO PREVENT OTHERS ENTERING?

No, cordoning off areas outside of your allocated camping spot is strictly prohibited.

CAN I BRING A GENERATOR?

Yes, generators are permitted.

Generators must adhere to noise guidelines during the 10pm – 7am quiet time.

PROHIBITED CONDUCT

(Refer also to the Conditions of Entry for further details)

- Uprooting or damaging any tree
- Blocking of thoroughfares
- Use of rope, bunting, temporary fencing to create segregated areas
- Depositing of litter, except in a receptacle provided for that purpose
- Behaving in any manner which would threaten the safety or enjoyment of other patrons or staff
- Damaging of any property, including the Go-Kart Track
- Riding Bikes on Go-Kart Track
- Music or excessive noise is prohibited from 10pm – 7am each day

VEHICLES

All Vehicles entering the campgrounds will require a valid accreditation sticker relevant to the campground being entered. There is no exception to this rule.

IDENTIFICATION

Patrons may be required to present their booking, campgrounds wristbands or valid ID by any security or event staff at any time. Please ensure you are wearing your wristband at all times in the campgrounds.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Any unregistered vehicles (mini bikes, electric scooters etc)
- Any bicycles
- Any alcoholic beverages not purchased within the venue
- Any glass (excluding sunglasses, binoculars and prescription glasses)
- Any animal (other than a guide dog)
- Any weapons
- Any electronic devices which may interfere with communications or broadcasting signals
- Any advertising banner, sign, poster or any promotional material marked on a tent
- Any fireworks or flares
- Any out of date/in poor condition gas bottles/leads. *(Campground management reserves the right to inspect all gas bottles/leads and condemn any which in its opinion may be of poor condition)*
